### MEMBERSHIP-ENROLMENT

To apply for membership, please fill in the enclosed application form, get it proposed and seconded by Life/Corporate members of the institute and send it along with the amount of Entrance Fee and subscription by demand draft to the Hon. General Secretary of the institute of Kolkata through the Secretary of the concerned chapter, if you reside within the territorial jurisdiction of any chapter, or directly, if you reside outside the jurisdiction of any of the chapters.

After the application has been scrutinised by NIPM Secretarial at Kolkata, it will be considered by the Membership Admission Committee and approved by the National Council. Thereafter, you will be informed of your admission to membership, indicating the class of membership and date of admission.

ndividual members are enrolled on the basis of financial year of the Institute. Any one admitted between April and September shall have to pay full year's subscription. Any one admitted between October and March shall have to pay half year's subscription. In both cases, entrance fee shall have to be paid in full.

# MEMBERSHIP - DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

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- 1. Every person admitted to any class of membership of NIPM shall be liable to follow in his/her professional practice, as a member in any rank of management, the CODE OF ETHICS of the institute and shall also make a genuine attempt to standards laid down in the code in all his/her dealings.
- Every person admitted to any class of membership of NIPM shall conduct himself/herself in such a manner as to preserve NIPM's image and dignity and shall not misuse authority or office for personal gain and self-interest.
- Every member will be liable to pay the appropriate annual subscription which becomes due and payable before 1st April every year.
- subscription within three months of the commencement of the year i.e. 30th June, shall be treated as a defaulter. If the defaulter fails to clear up their subscription latest by 30th September, their names are liable to be removed from membership.5. A person removed from the membership of the Institute may be readmitted as a member in the same class to which he/she belonged previously, by the Council, on an application made by him/her on that behalf, provided he/she clears up all arrear subscriptions before he/she can be readmitted by the Council.
- 6. A member shall ipso facto cease to be a member of the Institute on his/her death, or if he/she withdraws his/her membership or if he/she is adjudicated by a competent curt to be of unsound mind or is convicted for an offence involving moral turpitude. A Student member shall cease to be such

- The Council may, after due investigation, 7. suspend for any period any member from the membership of the Institute for any act of omission or commission which is in violation of the memorandum and regulations or is against the interest of the Institute or constitutes neglect or refusal to abide by any regulations and by-laws of the Institute or the concerned chapter, or is likely to bring discredit to the Institute, provided that no member shall be suspended unless he/she has been given an opportunity to explain his/her conduct. suspended member shall cease to be entitled to the benefits and rights of membership, but he/she shall have a rights of membership, but he/she shall have a right to appeal against such decision to the general body of the Institute in a general meeting immediately followed such suspension provided he/she files the memorandum of appeal with the general secretary within sixty days of his/her suspension.
- 8. Any member may be expelled from the Institute by the general body, provided that such decision is taken by a two-thirds majority vote of the members present at a general meeting held for the purpose and hte member proposed to be expelled has been given an opportunity to explain the charges leveled against him/her.

### NIPM-APROFILE

NIPM, the short form of the National Institute of Personnel Management, is now the only all-India body of professional managers engaged in the profession of personnel management, industrial relations, labour welfare, training and HRD in the country. NIPM came into existence in March 1980 as a result of merge of two professional institutions, namely, the Indian Institute of Personnel Management, established in 1948 and the National Institute of Labour Management established in 1950. With its National Office at Kolkata, NIPM has a total membership of more than 10000 spread over 52 Chapters all over the country. NIPM is a non-profit making body devoted to the development of skill and expertise of the persons engaged into the management of human resources through regular lecture meeting, seminars, training courses, conferences and publications through its Chapters throughout the country. One of its books "personnel Management in India", Which was prescribed as the basic text book on the subject by various universities and institutions, received subsidy from the National Book Trust. Its quarterly journal "Personnel Today" is subscribed by many Indian as well as foreign

NIPM has been consistently serving the cause of HRM profession in the country for the last four decades and representing the practioners in industry, both in private and public sectors, governments and academics. As the premier forum in the country.
